

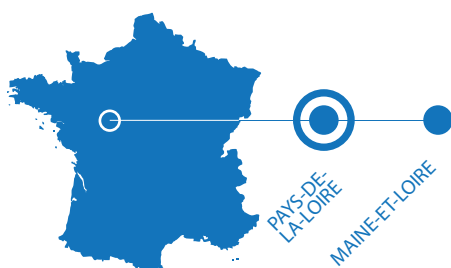


CHATEAU D'ANGERS

Guided tours of the chateau, gardens or Apocalypse Tapestry, masterpiece of medieval art, will bring a pleasant and cultural dimension to your receptions.

Availability

- Open all year round, subject to the calendar of cultural events.

Receptions

- Dinners, cocktail parties, meetings, seminars, concerts, exhibitions.

Special visits

- The Chateau d'Angers welcomes you outside normal opening hours, in the morning, to enjoy an exceptional experience. Take a guided tour lasting 2 hours for a special visit to the site. You can also enjoy breakfast in the morning or a glass of champagne and canapés in the evening.

- 15th century chapel:
250 m²
100 people seated or standing
- Governor's House:
4 interconnecting rooms with 18th century wood panelling
230 m² in total, with respective floor areas of 30 m², 44 m², 54 m² and 88 m², 120 people seated and 200 people standing, in total
- Gardens, ramparts:
700 people standing
- Apocalypse Gallery:
visit only
